### WORKSHOP FOR YOUNG ADULTS IN THE UNIVERSITY PARIS EST CRETEIL

Exploration activities of Europe, for master students and young teachers, with the resources developed and proposed by the EMEE project.

A diversified program is created, which allows the participants to reinterpret objects in an European perspective. The output of the activities will be displayed in the University and on Social Media platforms.

Young teachers conduct research on cultural partnership and implement pedagogical projects with target groups.

### PARTNERSHIP WITH CONTEMPORARY ARTISTS PROJECTS WITH MUSEUMS, CONTEMPORARY ARTISTS AND VISITORS

A series of workshops is held in partnership with the FRAAP, in order to disseminate the knowledge and to stimulate new approaches in the regions.

Two specific projects are developed with contemporary art associations, Art-Exprim and Espace 36.
